

Uniform Guidelines for Lower School (K4 – 4th grade)

Eastbrook Academy's dress code is intended to reflect the formal academic standard of the school and to avoid peer pressure in matters of attire. Students are expected to dress appropriately at all times. Children will be taken outdoors for recess whenever weather and school activities permit. With this in mind, please dress your child accordingly.

THIS DRESS CODE IS REQUIRED for all children. The Uniform Place has a copy of our dress code on file. Please also use the Lands' End catalog for a visual guideline or to order Logo wear. (If ordering from Lands' End, use "preferred school # 900032228". EBA receives a percentage back from each purchase.)

The plaid for girls' jumpers, skirts, and skorts is call BELAIR plaid—navy and hunter green with a red and yellow pin stripe. This plaid can be purchased from a uniform retailer—J.C. Penny Outlet, Target, Kohl's, and Lands' End.

Boys:

- Belted dress or corduroy slacks in khaki or navy (**no sagging pants**).
- Belted dress walking shorts in khaki or navy (cargo shorts are acceptable).
- Long or short sleeve shirts with collar (turtleneck, polo, or oxford style).
- Belts (mandatory for 2nd—4th grade).
- Shoes are open to personal preference, but should reflect the formal academic standards of the Academy.
- Shirts must be tucked in.

Girls:

- Dress slacks in khaki or navy (corduroy is acceptable).
- Walking shorts or skorts in khaki, navy, or Belair Plaid.
- Jumper/skirt in khaki, navy, or Belair plaid (any style jumper or skirt found in uniform stores is acceptable).
- Long or short sleeve shirt with collar (turtleneck, polo, peter-pan style). Blouses in white, yellow or light blue.
- Shoes, tights, hair accessories, etc. are open to personal preference, but should reflect the formal academic standards of the Academy. No flip-flop sandals.
- Girls may wear bike shorts or leggings under skirts for recess.

Sweater, vest, and shirt colors:

Solid red, yellow, white, green, dark or light blue.

Please Note:

- No writing on shirts.
- Hats and hoods are not to be worn inside the school building.
- Any Eastbrook Academy LOGO clothing may be worn as part of the school dress code. Logo t-shirts may be worn on days children have physical education class.
- We have dress code clothing available at no cost for those who are in need.
